ARGENTINA MENDOZA

BODEGA RUCA MALEN

MALBEC 2004

£9.99

Organically produced, this fabulous wine is 85% Malbec, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Merlot. It has a peppery nose and lashings of sumptuous soft black fruits with a touch of spice and a hint of oak. Really wonderful

AUSTRALIA SOUTH/SOUTH EAST

HEYWOOD

SHIRAZ, South East Australia 2006

£6.49

Deep plum-blackberry in colour, this has a sweetly-fruited, intense nose and palate, rich in bright fruit and laced with spice. More subtle than most Australian reds and all the better for it.

CABERNET-MERLOT, South East Australia 2004

£6.29

This presents very concentrated, ripe fruit on the nose, echoed on the palate, which shows intense, fresh berries, lifted with peppered notes and delicate spice.

COLOMBARD-CHARDONNAY, South East Australia 2006

£6.29

Straw colour, with an abundance of fresh apple aromas. Peaches, lemon and melon fruits. It is a crisp, mouthfilling and fruit driven wine with good length

SAUVIGNON BLANC, South Australia 2006

£6.49

'Proof that Australia can do mouthwatering, great-value sauvignon', Joanna Simon in The Sunday Times, 5th February 2006

FRANCE BORDEAUX

CANON FRONSAC

CHATEAU MAZERIS 2003

£11.49

Briary, dark fruits on the nose with traces of summer pudding. The palate shows very full creamy fruit almost succulent in style, a firm structure and nice length to the finish.

HAUT-MEDOC

CHATEAU DE LAMARQUE 1999

£15.99

A charming wine with chocolate, spices and mouth watering-filled red fruits, intermingled with the most delicate traces of oak. Text book claret.

POMEROL

C&B POMEROL 2004, Ets J-P Moueix

£13.49

This has a lovely ruby colour with soft plummy black fruit on the nose. Supple and round on the palate, it has quite lively ripe fruits with a musky hint of sweetness, velvetybalanced tannins and a medium length on the finish.

DOMAINE TRIGANT DE BOISSET 2004

£16.49

Firm ruby in colour, the nose is still a little subdued with hints of leafy, black fruits, earth and mint. In contrast, the palate is silkily rich with sweet, toffee flavours, good grip and a fat, plump freshness to the finish. Superb.

L'HOSPITALET DE GAZIN 2003

£19.49

Second wine of Gazin, the immediate neighbour of Pétrus, this was a great success in 2003. The nose is lovely, rich in sweet, gamey, toasty red fruit whilst the palate is succulent, supple and rich with a generous structure and full, satisfying finish.

FRANCE BORDEAUX

PREMIERES COTES DE BORDEAUX

L'ORANGERIE DE CARIGNAN 2004

£8.79

A bright, vibrant wine suitable for early drinking. The grapes comes from the estate's younger vines and see no oak. Joyously fruity with hints of cedar and spice on top of the blackcurrant and raspberry flavours. A firm favourite.

ST EMILION

CHATEAU BARRAIL DU BLANC 2005

£16.19

This tiny property has been managed by the same family for 150 years. A really lovely early drinking St. Emilion with smooth, seductive, juicy and elegant flavours.

FRANCE BURGUNDY

CHABLIS DOMAINE SERVIN 2006/7

£11.79

The Chablis, from the western bank of the Serein river is almost champagne-like on the nose, with seashell minerality and biscuit notes to the fore.

CHABLIS LES DEUX RIVES 2005

£12.49

The cuvée is a blend of grapes from both sides of the Serein River, hence the name. The majority of the vines are more than 30 years old. Grapes are handpicked and vinified in stainless steel tanks.

BOURGOGNE BLANC LES SETILLES 2006

£11.79

Made from vineyards around Puligny and Mersault, this is at once rich and steely with a balanced palate.

MOULIN-A-VENT LES BRIGANDES, CHATEAU DE LANCIE 2005

£11.49

This wine has a lovely deep garnet colour with scarlet highlights. On the nose, it exhibits floral and spicy aromas with cassis and iris hints. A supple wine with concentrated ripe fruit flavours.

FLEURIE VIELLES VIGNES 2006, JOUBERT

£12.29

Accessible, fresh and bright this has great charm with ripe cherry and plum fruit. Made from 100% Gamay.

FRANCE CHAMPAGNE

DELAMOTTE

DELAMOTTE BRUT NV

£20.99

50% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Noir and 20% Pinot Meunier. Chalky soil. First fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Malolactic fermentation. Minimum of three years maturation in bottle.

DELAMOTTE ROSE NV

£32.99

80% Pinot Noir, 20% Chardonnay. Chalky soil. First fermentation in stainless steel tanks. No maceration. Malolactic fermentation three years maturation in bottle.

DELAMOTTE BLANC DE BLANCS NV

£28.99

100% Chardonnay (from 3 different 100% crus in Cote de Blancs – Avize, Oger & Le Mesnil sur Oger). Chalky soil. First fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Malolactic fermentation. Minimum of four years maturation in bottle.

DELAMOTTE BLANC DE BLANCS 1999

£33.99

100% Chardonnay. Chalky soil. First fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Malolactic fermentation five years maturation in bottle.

FRANCE REGIONAL

- LA BROUETTE, VDP D'OC NV** £5.79
Very supple and ripe with very smooth, well-integrated, almost imperceptible tannins, this is a very straightforward, gentle wine.
- LA BROUETTE, VDP DU GERS NV** £5.79
Fresh, bright white with attractive aromatics and hints of orchard and citrus fruit. Nicely balanced.
- DOMAINE DE SAISSAC CABERNET SAUVIGNON, VDP D'OC 2005** £6.49
Made from Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine has delicious berry fruits and a slight touch of oak. It offers claret style drinking with a softer, sunnier edge.
- LES ECSCASSES, VIN DE PAYS DES COTES CATALANES 2006** £5.99
Brilliant pale yellow-green. Fresh, intense floral and tropical fruit aromas are matched by flavours of ripe apples, pineapples and white peach. The palate is ripe and rounded with a lively citrus finish.
- MARQUIS DE LISSAC CHARDONNAY 2006** £6.49
Freshness is key here. The grapes are picked at night and remain on their lees for two to four months being stirred regularly. The wine shows tremendous vitality, with an additional grapey richness on the mid-palate.
- LA COMBE DE GRINO, BERGERAC 2006** £6.99
A domaine bottled blend of 50% fresh, grassy Sauvignon Blanc and 50% rich Sémillon, offering fabulous dry yet slightly honeyed fruits that will evolve throughout the year.
- CLOT DE GLEIZE, VDP DES BOUCHES DU RHONE 2006** £6.79
'A heavy curtain of tannin weighs down the intense ripe fruit and flavour, and there is no doubt that this wine has the capacity to mature into something full of summery warmth and indolence. A definite bargain at the price, and worth keeping for a year', Roger Scruton in The New Statesman, 27th March 2006
- COMBE DE GRINOU ROUGE, BERGERAC 2006** £6.99
The sister wine to our excellent and ever popular house white, this is alluring, ripe and generous with a sweet intensity and spicy backdrop. 70% Merlot and 30% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- DOMAINE DE MONTAUBERON ROSE, VDP DES CÔTES DE THONGUE 2006** £6.59
This is a very pretty, pale colour, very clean and pure. It really lifts the spirit with fresh vitality and bright, berried fruit -strawberries and cream in a glass with an attractive hint of white pepper adding definition - almost too easy really.
- DOMAINE DE MONTAUBERON VIOGNIER VDP DES CÔTES DE THONGUE 2006** £6.99
Fresh peach and floral notes with a rich, mineral palate. A lovely wine with traditional Viognier characteristics.
- PINOT NOIR, DOMAINE DES SALICES (J&F LURTON), VDP D'OC 2004** £7.79
This is a real find, a well made Pinot Noir from the Pays d'Oc! Red berries and pink peppercorns make for a splendid and really delicious easy drinking wine.
- CHATEAU LA LIQUIERE CUVÉE DES AMANDIERS, FAUGERES 2006** £8.59
This provides an attractive, classical style and is beautifully balanced, drinking well now but with the ability to age. It reveals enticingly aromatic, fresh red and black fruit supported by a ripe, well-integrated, tannic structure.
- PETIT BOURGEOIS SAUVIGNON BLANC 2006, HENRI BOURGEOIS** £8.29
People tend to refer to this as 'poor man's Sancerre' which does this lovely wine a great disservice. It puts many a real Sancerre to shame with a very pure expression of richly weighted citrus and gooseberry fruit.

FRANCE RHONE

COTES DU RHONE 2005, VIGNOBLES GONNET £7.99
Very supple and ripe with very smooth, well-integrated, almost imperceptible tannins, this is a very straightforward, gentle wine.

ITALY

PRIMITIVO DI TARANTINO, MASSERIA DEI TRULLARI 2006 £6.99
Very supple and ripe with very smooth, well-integrated, almost imperceptible tannins, this is a very straightforward, gentle wine with cherry and vanilla notes.

MORELLINO DI SCANSANO, MORIS FARMS 2005 £11.99
Deep plum-ruby with a cherry rim, this presents sweet, accessible black and red fruit on both the nose and palate. Rich and layered, complex, aromatic and bright.

LE CUPOLE DI TRINORO 2004 £21.19
43% Cabernet Franc, 27% Merlot, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Cesanese d'Affile, the incredibly sweet fruit which had dominated the nose a year ago has now given way to much darker, richer, savoury notes layered with dark chocolate, warm fruitcake and cream. Marvellous!

SOUTH AFRICA

NELSON'S CREEK SAUVIGNON BLANC, PAARL 2007 £7.39
What a wine! Zingy gooseberry on the nose with bags of tropical and green apple fruit, very fresh and absolutely delicious.

SPAIN

MAS OLIVERAS TEMPRANILLO, CATALUNYA 2005 £5.99
Bright ruby-violet colour. Intense and scented on the nose, with undertones of ripe strawberries and liquorice. The palate offers supple, fresh summer berry and black fruit flavours, soft rich textures and a warm finish.

TAJA MONASTRELL, JUMILLA 2006 £6.99
'From the hilly vineyards in Jumilla, in south-easter Spain, comes this hugely enjoyable red. Really ripe, juicy and jammy, with a long, warming finish', Jonathan Ray in the Daily Telegraph, 22th February 2006 on the 2005 vintage

PETALOS DE BIERZO, BIERZO 2006 £12.49
Deep violet, this is peppery with vibrant scents of dark cherry, cassis and tobacco. It has sweet red and dark berry flavours, tangy acids and balanced fine-grained tannins.
